Summer Camp Code of Conduct

The ultimate goal of the Code of Conduct is ensure a safe environment where campers demonstrate respect for themselves, their peers and their counselors. We have basically four rules

1. Safety
2. Respect
3. Try your best
4. Have fun

Every camper has the right to participate.

Every camper has the right to be free from harassment (bullying, teasing, etc).

Every camper has the right to a safe, fun camp experience.

Campers who infringe on the rights of others will be disciplined with appropriate consequences, including withdrawal from camp.

Campers can be excluded from camp and camp activities for the following:

1. Selling, using, or possessing alcohol, drugs, or other controlled substances.
2. Selling, using, or possessing dangerous materials or instruments including (but not limited to) fireworks, lighters, matches, knives, or weapons unless the materials are part of a camp activity.
3. Creating a hazardous situation or environment.
4. Fighting, violent behavior, or activities that endanger safety.
5. Insubordination that threatens health and safety or disrupts the camp activities.
6. Smoking.
7. Gambling.
8. Deliberate destruction of camp or the personal property of others. Replacement or compensation will be expected.
9. The use of abusive or obscene language and gestures.
- 10. Absolutely no racial, religious, ethnic, or sexual slurs will be allowed.**

There will be **absolutely no refunds** for campers who are forced to leave camp or camp activities for breaking the Code of Conduct.
